Skene Catling de la Peña

Skene Catling (b. 1965) co-founded Skene Catling de la Peña, where she is an architect and director, with Jaime de la Peña in London in 2003. The practice is known for integrating contemporary projects into heritage-listed buildings, such as the Perm World Heritage Site in Russia (2010). The Flint House (below), a wedge-shaped residence clad in flint arranged in graduating tones, won the Royal Institute of British Architects House of the Year award in 2015. Skene Catling teaches at the Karlsruhe Institute of Technology in Germany.
